



## Initial and Refresher Training for Ammonia Awareness and Response

### This course covers the OSHA requirements for:

- Refresher training for emergency response technician level personnel who will respond to leaks or spills of chemicals for the purpose of stopping the leak or spill and neutralizing it.
- Initial/ Refresher training of first responder **OPERATIONS** level personnel who will respond defensively to leaks for the purpose of protecting nearby persons, property, or the environment from the effects of the release.

### Course material includes but is not limited to:

- Hazards confronting responders
- Health effects of ammonia
- Procedures for handling emergency responses defensively
- How to plan/prepare for emergencies and identify risks
- How to decontaminate responders and neutralize/clean up ammonia spills
- Protective clothing
- Respiratory protection training including self-contained breathing apparatuses (SCBA's) and respirators
- Open forum discussion on ammonia safety
- Proper leak isolation techniques
- Ammonia leak detection options
- Question and answer period
- Certificates of completion will be issued.
